Our intention is to use "white" colored ball for the tournaments, but an "electric yellow" ball version is also available, and both are approved for play. This information was just received today.

Schools are not mandated to purchase the official IHSAA state game ball for your regular season soccer matches, but as you look to place your soccer ball order for 2022-23, please keep in mind that the Wilson Vivdo will be the tournament game ball for our Fall 2022-23 Soccer season. We understand that whenever a ball change is made, the first year is certainly a "transition" year. All Wilson NFHS Approved soccer balls are approved for play. Wilson Sporting Goods is the official ball partner of the IHSAA.
