Description:

Parker is funny, witty, loving, and honest. He is always an inspiration to others to practice inclusivity and kindness.

General Criteria:

- 1. Recipient must be a Unified Partner Athlete.
- 2. Recipient must be a graduating senior from an IHSAA member school.
- 3. Recipient must have participated in the Champions Together program for at least two (2) years (2 years = Sr./Jr., not just 2 unified sport seasons in 1 year).
- 4. Recipient must show team spirit, leadership, sportsmanship, and character.
- 5. Recipient must be planning to attend post-secondary education (4-year college, 2-year college, trade/technical school) in Indiana and demonstrate a financial need.
- 6. It is preferred the recipient participated in both Unified Flag Football and Unified Track and Field.

- 7. Selection criteria may include, but not require, whether the recipient is a 1st generation family member to attend post-secondary education.
- 8. Recipient will be selected by the IHSAA Foundation Scholarship Committee (which includes the IHSAA Commissioner and IHSAA Foundation President).
- 9. This scholarship award will be presented annually at the IHSAA Champions Together Awards Luncheon or at the recipient's senior scholarship awards program.
- 10. This is a one-time scholarship award for the selected student.
