

IHSAA Bobby and Kathy Cox Scholarship (4 @ \$1,000)

Description:

The Bobby and Kathy Cox Scholarship Endowment Fund was created in 2020 after Bobby Cox's retirement as commissioner of the IHSAA. He and his wife Kathy were long time administrators in the state of Indiana, with 74 years of combined years as educators and supporters of education-based athletics.

Eligible student-athletes must be nominated by their schools' principal and athletic director. A candidate must be a first-generation post-secondary education attendee, a multi-sport athlete, participate during each year of high school, and show teamwork, leadership, and good character.

General Criteria:

1. The recipient must be a graduating senior or in her/his final year at an IHSAA member school.
2. The recipient must be planning to attend post-secondary education (4-year college, 2-year college, trade/technical school) in Indiana.
3. The recipient must be a first-generation family member to attend post-secondary education.
4. The recipient must show teamwork, leadership, and good character.
5. It is preferred the recipient be a multi-sport athlete and earned a varsity letter in at least two (2) different IHSAA sports.
6. It is preferred the recipient played at least one (1) IHSAA sport during each year of high school.

Supporting education-based athletics for the next generation.

7. It is preferred the recipient was a member of the school's Student Athlete Advisory Council (SAAC) and/or attended the IHSAA Student Leadership Conference (SLC).
8. Recipients will be selected by the IHSAA Foundation Scholarship Committee (which includes the IHSAA Commissioner and IHSAA Foundation President).
9. This is a one-time scholarship awarded to the selected recipients. 10. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the student for postsecondary expenses.
